



Stay ahead of the grads!....having actual practical skills and experience gives you the 'employability factor'










Money

How long is an Apprenticeship course?

- Apprenticeships can take between a minimum of one year and four years to complete depending on the level
- There are 4 levels of Apprenticeships available:

Level 2 – Intermediate Level Apprenticeship
Level 3 – Advanced Level Apprenticeship
Level 4 – Higher Apprenticeship
Level 5/6 – Degree Apprenticeship










Higher and Degree Apprenticeships
