Mobile Phones

Mobile phones can be a great tool and resource, however, we do see lots of our Y7 students using these inappropriately outside of school, for example, not being aware of their surroundings whilst walking home/waiting for the bus, or using Social Media inappropriately. We have also experienced students being victims of crime purely because of something they have clicked on or signed up to on their phone. As parents/guardians, it is important that you are monitoring your child's phone usage and raising any concerns with the Y7 pastoral team. At CBSC we know how important it is to keep our students well fed. One of the first things Mr Barber did when he became the Principal of CBSC was to employ a chef to provide a range of food for our young people.
